
Chapter 7 reading frame: Understanding a complicated plot

Ralph, Jack, Simon, and the other hunters leave the Castle Rock after looking for the beast and head back to their camp. Ralph stops and makes some realizations.


How is this side of the island different from the side they crashed on?




And as Ralph is looking over the ocean, what does Simon do to make him feel better?




The boys decide to hunt their way back to camp and for the first time, on page 111 we get some history about Ralph's life. What are some of the things he remembers?




What happens to interrupt his thinking about home?




What might Golding be doing putting these two scenes right next to each other? This might take some thought to come up with. Try your best.




What do they do to poor Robert after the boar encounter?
